It was founded in 1869 by King William I of Prussia, who later became German Emperor, as a naval base for Prussia's developing fleet. Today, Wilhelmshaven is still Germany's largest naval base. It also is Germany's only deep-water port. It is easily accessible from the airports in Hamburg and Bremen.
