Call for contribution – Jade International Week Tourism Symposium

I would like to invite you to contribute to a half day symposium on "Current Issues in Tourism" on 25 April 2019 held during the international week at Jade University of Applied Sciences in Wilhelmshaven, Germany.

The continuous growth of the tourism industry provides opportunities and challenges. Tourism can contribute to economic growth, provide job opportunities and further cultural exchange. However, while many tourists want to 'live like a local' and have an authentic immersive experience, tourist destinations across the globe struggle with visitor numbers. - Tourism workforce / HR / modern slavery
- ICT/E-Tourism/Sharing economy/Social Media
- Media representations of tourism
- Wellness tourism
- Tourism mobilities

Format:

Participants present their papers in 10 minutes followed by 5 minutes for questions. The day will end with a roundtable discussion.
